The Foltz Martin summer associate program provides one or two exceptional law students the opportunity to fully experience our Firm's practice areas. We focus on candidates from the University of Georgia and Emory University Schools of Law, although we do accept resumes from candidates nationwide.

Our summer program is intended to be a substantive learning experience for the summer associate of the practice of business law and an opportunity for the Firm to evaluate his or her potential as a practitioner.

During the summer program, our summer associates work on assignments coming from each of our three practice groups: Commercial Real Estate, Complex Commercial Litigation and Corporate Law. Within these practice groups, our office has approximately 16 lawyers working in the following primary areas: Business Torts; Hotels, Restaurants and Lodging; Retail Development; Corporate Finance; Mergers & Acquisitions; Private Equity; Business Divorces; Construction Law; Partnerships and Joint Ventures; Secured Lending; Trademark and Copyright; Mediation/Arbitration; Creditor/Debtor Relations; Trusts & Estates, Executive Employment Agreements and Computer and Technology Law.

An associate attorney manages the workload of each summer associate to ensure the experience is similar to what one could expect as a junior associate. Our summer associates often are able to work side by side with our attorneys on client matters, as well as observing closings, hearings, client meetings, negotiation sessions, depositions and trials whenever possible. Summer associates regularly receive informal feedback from the attorneys with whom they work throughout the summer and a formal review at the end of the program. We strive to have our summer associates work with each partner and as many associates as possible.

Summer associates are also invited to enjoy lunches, happy hours and dinners and other informal activities by individual attorneys.

Students are welcome to split their summers with other firms provided they spend at least six weeks in our office in order for the summer associate and the Firm to get to know each other.
